Learn beginning response tactics and sizing up an emergency situation.

Learn basic concepts and hands-on skills in:

fire behavior and suppression

damage assessment, light search and rescue

disaster first aid, assisting people with special needs

neighborhood emergency communications

Form teams and practice your skills in a simulated earthquake exercise.

The classroom instruction, hands-on training and practice exercise are conducted by firefighters at the Oakland Fire Training Center.

When you complete CORE I, II, and III, you receive a “graduation” certificate, CORE hat and vest with CORE photo ID, and are registered as a Disaster Service Worker.

Note that participants are required to take both Class A and Class B with the hands-on training and exercise to complete CORE training. Participants must have already completed CORE I and CORE II before taking CORE III.
